STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Elections in City of Biddeford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1933, c. 71, § 2, amended. The next to the last sentence of the first paragraph of section 2 of chapter 71 of the private and special laws of 1933, as last repealed and replaced by chapter 102 of the private and special laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

Only those voters enrolled as qualified to vote in such caucuses as hereinafter provided shall participate therein; all nominations by petition or as provided by the Maine Revised Statutes shall be voted upon at the next municipal election, and the caucus for such candidates by petition or by said nomination papers shall be held in the several wards of the city on the last Monday of November annually biennially, on which day, the polls will be opened at 9 o'clock in the forenoon and continue to 8 o'clock in the evening, when they shall close.
