STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Enabling Municipalities to Charge for the Readiness to Serve of Their Municipal Sewer Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4355, amended. Section 4355 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 4355. Service charges for sewage disposal

The municipal officers may establish a schedule of service charges from time to time upon improved real estate connected with a municipal sewer or disposal system for the use of the system and a schedule of readiness to service charges from time to time upon real estate whether improved or unimproved, abutting on or accessible to, sewers or drains of the municipality, but not actually connected thereto. Such service charges shall and readiness to service charges may include reserve fund contributions. The charges shall be collected according to section 4453.
