AN ACT Relating to Authority of State Employees Appeals Board.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., T. 5, § 678, amended. Section 678 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 2 of chapter 539 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows :

§ 678. Dismissal and disciplinary action

An appointing authority may dismiss, suspend or otherwise discipline an employee for cause. This right is subject to the right of appeal and arbitration of grievances set forth in sections 751 to 753; and sections 751 to 753 shall apply only to any employee who has attained permanent status in such employment.
