STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Increasing the Salary of the Governor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 2, § 1, amended. The last paragraph of section 1 of Title 2 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

The Governor shall receive an annual salary of \$20,000 \$40,000.

- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the Executive Department from the General Fund the sum of \$10,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
- Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective the first Wednesday of January, 1971.
