SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1354, L D. 1683, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Certain Classified Employees in the Forestry Department."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 676, shall not apply to any of the above employees who, as of October 1, 1969, had satisfactorily completed at least 6 months of state service immediately previous to that date. Any employee, who had not completed 6 months of said state service prior to October 1, 1969, shall have the time served counted toward his probationary service.'
