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**AN ACT** Relating to Certain Classified Employees in the  
Forestry Department.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1969, c. 147, amended.** Chapter 147 of the private and special laws of 1969, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

**The Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 676, shall not apply to any of the above employees who, as of the effective date of this Act, have satisfactorily completed at least 6 months of state service.**
