**AN ACT Relating to Municipal Zoning Ordinance Affecting Indian Lands.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

**R. S., T. 22, § 4709-A, additional.** Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4709-A, to read as follows:

**§ 4709-A. Municipal zoning ordinances affecting Indian lands**

No municipality, which borders on Indian lands, shall enact a zoning ordinance which legally affects such Indian lands, unless such municipality first obtains the approval of the tribal council of the reservation concerned.
