STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Municipal Zoning Ordinance Affecting Indian Lands.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 4709-A, additional. Title 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 4709-A, to read as follows:

§ 4709-A. Municipal zoning ordinances affecting Indian lands

No municipality, which borders on Indian lands, shall enact a zoning ordinance which legally affects such Indian lands, unless such municipality first obtains the approval of the tribal council of the reservation concerned.
