## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT To Extend the Period During Which the Trustees of Harrison Water District Have to Acquire Properties Owned by Harrison Water Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1969, c. 91, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 91 of the private and special laws of 1969 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 16. Act void unless property and franchise of Harrison Water Company is acquired. If said district, pursuant to the provisions hereof, shall fail to purchase or file its petition to take by eminent domain, within one year 3 years from the date of the first meeting of the board of trustees, provided in section 7 hereof, the plant, properties, franchises, rights and privileges owned by Harrison Water Company and used or usable in supplying water to a part of the Town of Harrison and to that part of the Town of Bridgton known as North Bridgton, then this Act shall be inoperative, null and void.
