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**AN ACT To Extend the Period During Which the Trustees of Harrison Water District Have to Acquire Properties Owned by Harrison Water Company.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1969, c. 91, § 16, amended.** Section 16 of chapter 91 of the private and special laws of 1969 is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 16. Act void unless property and franchise of Harrison Water Company is acquired.** If said district, pursuant to the provisions hereof, shall fail to purchase or file its petition to take by eminent domain, within ~~one year~~ **3 years** from the date of the first meeting of the board of trustees, provided in section 7 hereof, the plant, properties, franchises, rights and privileges owned by Harrison Water Company and used or usable in supplying water to a part of the Town of Harrison and to that part of the Town of Bridgton known as North Bridgton, then this Act shall be inoperative, null and void.
