# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

### AN ACT Relating to Hours of Sale in Retail Stores Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended.** The first sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 44-A of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

No liquor shall be sold in this State on Sundays except as hereinafter provided, and no licensee by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall, between the hours of midnight and 6 a.m., sell or deliver any liquors, except no liquors shall be sold or delivered on Saturdays after 11:45 p.m. and except that in restaurants, class A restaurants, class A taverns, hotels, **retail stores** and clubs liquor may, except as provided, be sold to 1 a.m.
