SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 576,
L. D. 1703, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Assessment
of Municipalities in Aid to Dependent Children Grants."

Amend said Amendment by striking out in the 7th, 8th and 9th
lines the following: "and there is appropriated from the
Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,125,000
for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971!"

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the 3rd line
from the end the figure "\$2,250,000" and inserting in place thereof
the figure '\$1,125,000'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out in the last
line the word, figures and punctuation "July 1, 1970" and inserting
in place thereof the following 'January 1, 1971'
