COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 576, L.D. 1703, Bill,
"AN ACT Repealing the Law Requiring Assessment of Municipalities
in Aid to Dependent Children Grants."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbrevia-
tion and figure 'Sec. 1' (same in L.D.)

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 2 Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
General Fund the sum of \$1,125,000 for the fiscal year ending
June 30, 1971 and there is appropriated from the Unappropriated
Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,125,000 for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out the purposes of
this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

HEALTH AND WELFARE, DEPT. OF

Aid to Dependent Children

All Other \$ 2,250,000

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become effective
July 1, 1970.'
