COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 580, L. D. 1707, Bill,  
"AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Union River Anadromous Fish  
Restoration Program."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting  
clause and inserting in place thereof:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund  
to the Atlantic Sea-Run Salmon Commission, the sum of \$41,500  
for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1971 to carry out a program  
of anadromous fish restoration in the waters of the Union River  
Bay and estuary. All unexpended balances shall not lapse but  
shall remain a continuing account until June 30, 1973. The ap-  
propriation is contingent upon additional moneys being provided,  
from local sources or whatever sources the Atlantic Sea-Run  
Salmon Commission may find available, in the amount of \$18,500  
to supplement the state's contribution to complete the program.  
It is the intent of the Legislature that federal funds may be  
used in this project but not in place of the \$18,500 matching  
moneys. The breakdown of expenditures shall be as follows:
