SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO S. P. 581, L. D. 1708, Bill, "AN ACT
Appropriating Funds for Providing Shade Trees Through the
Forestry Department."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 3 and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the
Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Forestry
Department the sum of \$25,000 to carry out the purposes of
this Act. Any balance at the end of the fiscal year shall
not lapse but shall be carried forward into the following
year to be expended for the same purposes. The breakdown
shall be as follows:

All Other	\$25,000'
