HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 533, L. D. 1710, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing for Immunity to Members of Ski Patrols in
Emergency Cases."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Emergency preamble
and the Emergency clause.

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line
(3rd in L.D.) of that part designated "§ 154" the underlined words
"the ski patrol with" and inserting in place thereof the following:
'a ski patrol within'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end of the last
paragraph before the Emergency clause (same in L.D.) the following
underlined sentence:

'This section shall not exempt such a member of a ski patrol within
the National Ski Patrol System from negligence while operating a
motor vehicle.'
