**AN ACT** Relating to Property Tax Exemption for Nature Conservancy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 36, § 652, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, amended.** Paragraph D of subsection 1 of section 652 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**D.** The real estate and personal property owned and occupied or used solely for their own purposes by the American National Red Cross, **The Nature Conservancy** and ~~its~~ their respective chapters in this State.
