STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Property Tax Exemption for Nature Conservancy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 652, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, amended. Paragraph D of subsection 1 of section 652 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - D. The real estate and personal property owned and occupied or used solely for their own purposes by the American National Red Cross, The Nature Conservancy and its their respective chapters in this State.
