AN ACT Relating to Definition of School Bus.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2011, amended. The first paragraph of section 2011 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 113 and as amended by section 19 of chapter 425, both of the public laws of 1967, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The term "school bus" includes every motor vehicle with a carrying capacity of 10 or more passengers operated for the transportation of children to or from school, to or from any school activities at a private or public school, or to and from any nonschool activity within the State in which use of a bus has been approved by the school committee, community school committees or board of directors. School as used in this sentence shall mean either a private or public school. Buses operated by a motor carrier having a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Public Utilities Commission under Title 35, sections 1501 to 1518 which comply with the requirements of the commission shall not be regarded as "school buses."
