COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1374, L. D. 1723,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Bag Limit on Bears."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "§ 2355-B" (same in L.D.) and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'§ 2355-B. Bag limit on bears

It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, trap, take
or kill, or have in possession more than one bear in any calendar
year, except the commissioner may authorize the taking of nuisance
bears ~~and-except-any-cub-born-during-such-calendar-year.~~'
