STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1374, L.D. 1723, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Bag Limit on Bears."

Amend said Bill in the Title by adding after the word "Bears" the words 'and Roadside Menagerie Permits for Bear'

Further amend said Bill by adding after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) the following section:

'Sec. 1. R.S., T. 12, §1904, sub-§3, amended. The last 2 paragraphs of subsection 3 of section 1904 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 115 of the public laws of 1969, are amended to read as follows:

Holders of a "roadside menagerie" permit may be issued breeder's permits for moose and, caribou and bear, and may sell same, or their offspring, only with the permission of the commissioner.

The commissioner is empowered to make rules and regulations for the keeping and disposing of live moose and, caribou and bear, and may prescribe and furnish identification to be worn by such moose and, caribou and bear.

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line (same in L.D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'
