AN ACT Relating to Bag Limit on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2355-B, amended. Section 2355-B of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 289 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

§ 2355-B. Bag limit on bears

It shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, trap, take or kill, or have in possession more than one bear in any calendar year ~~except the commissioner may authorize the taking of nuisance bears and except any cub born during~~ such calendar year.
