STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT to Permit Probable Cause Arrest on Marijuana Misdemeanor Violations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 2383, sub-§ 3, additional. Section 2383 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 7 of chapter 443 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new subsection 3, to read as follows:

3. Enforcement. Any sheriff, deputy sheriff, constable, municipal or state police officer, if he has probable cause to believe that a violation of this section has taken place or is taking place, may arrest without a warrant, any person for violation of this section whether or not that violation was committed in his presence.
