STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to County Purchases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 304, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 304 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 219 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The county commissioners shall make all All purchases over \$250 \$500 of services, supplies, materials and equipment needed by for the county, or any department or agency thereof shall be awarded by the county commissioners by a system of competitive bidding conducted in manner similar to that described in Title 5, section 1816, or by utilizing the services of the State Bureau of Purchases. Title 5, section 1816, shall govern such purchases as far as applicable
