Sec. 3. P. L., 1969, c. 491, § 2, amended. The last sentence of section 2 of chapter 491 of the Public Laws of 1969 is repealed and the following sentences enacted in place thereof:

The Attorney General of the State of Maine shall act as chairman pro tem of the first board meeting. The election of officers, to include a chairman, vice chairman, and a secretary for the ensuing year will be held at the second meeting.
