STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Amending the Maine Police Academy Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 25, § 2802, amended. The first paragraph of section 2802 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 491 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The Maine Police Academy shall be under the direct control and supervision of a Board of Commissioners consisting of 7 members as follows: The Attorney General, the Chief of the Maine State Police, ex officio, and the following to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council: A county attorney, a sheriff and 3 other persons who shall be officers chiefs of municipal police departments and members of the Maine Law Enforcement Council.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 25, § 2803, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2803 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 491 of of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

The Board of Commissioners shall employ, subject to the terms of the Personnel Law, full time trained personnel who are trained as experienced law enforcement officers. They shall be classified in rank or position to comparable positions within the Maine State Police as deemed necessary for the operation of the academy and classification of comparable positions will be determined by the board. Sec. 3. P. L., 1969, c. 491, § 2, amended. The last sentence of section 2 of chapter 491 of the Public Laws of 1969 is repealed and the following sentences enacted in place thereof:

The Attorney General of the State of Maine shall act as chairman pro tem of the first board meeting. The election of officers, to include a chairman, vice chairman, and a secretary for the ensuing year will be held at the second meeting.
