STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT to Make Direct Billing of Property and Casualty Insurance Voluntary.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 24-A, § 2164-A, additional. Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new section 2164-A, to read as follows:

§ 2164-A. Direct billing, voluntary

No contract of property or casualty insurance shall be made, renewed or operated on a direct billing basis, unless express written approval of same is obtained in advance from the insured or from the resident agent who issues or countersigns same.
