**AN ACT Extending the Time for Licensing of Ambulance Service, Vehicles  
and Personnel.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 32, § 61, amended.** Section 61 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 359 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

**§ 61. Requirement for license**

No ambulance service shall operate after June 30, ~~1970~~ 1972 unless it has been duly licensed by the Department of Health and Welfare pursuant to this chapter.
