STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Extending the Time for Licensing of Ambulance Service, Vehicles and Personnel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 61, amended. Section 61 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 359 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

§ 61. Requirement for license

No ambulance service shall operate after June 30, 1970 1972 unless it has been duly licensed by the Department of Health and Welfare pursuant to this chapter.
