COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 586, L.D. 1741,
Bill, "AN ACT Amending the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of the emergency preamble, and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Whereas, commercial airlines and ferry services require complete eating facilities including supplies of spirituous and vinous liquors at points of departure on national and international flights and ferry trips; and'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by inserting after the word "airlines" in the 6th line (5th line of L.D.) the underlined words 'and ferry services'
