# AN ACT Adjusting Salaries of Certain Unclassified State Personnel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1969, c. 155, § 5, additional. Chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1969 is amended by adding a new section 5 to read as follows:
- Sec. 5. Unclassified employees subject to legislative determination. All unclassified officials and employees whose salaries are set by the Legislature shall receive the same salary adjustment provided in section 1. This adjustment shall be retroactive to the effective date of section 1.
