**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Maine Maritime Academy for Library  
Acquisitions and Salary Increases.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Maritime Academy the sum of \$100,000 for acquisitions for the academy library, to meet accreditation requirements of the New England Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, and the sum of \$60,000 for increases in salaries to compensate for increases in the cost of living and to maintain a level of compensation acceptable to the accrediting association.
