STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
AND SEVENTY

AN ACT to Authorize Town of Winterport to Form a School Administrative District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

School Administrative District for Winterport, authorized. The municipality of Winterport is exempted from the limitations provided in the Revised Statutes of 1964, Title 20, section 213, and the State Board of Education is authorized to proceed pursuant to sections 214 to 307 to take the necessary action to allow the municipality of Winterport to form a School Administrative District. Said district shall be authorized to procure secondary education for its pupils at one or more administrative units or with one or more private academies. Further, notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the contrary, the Winterport School Administrative District shall be governed by a board of directors not to exceed 3 in number.

Nothing contained in this Act shall be construed to limit the number of times that Winterport may make application to the State Board of Education nor shall the authority heretofore granted to the State Board of Education under this Act be limited to any specified number of times for the board to authorize Winterport to act on the formation of a School Administrative District.
