COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1401, L. D. 1757, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Violations by Guides Under Fish  
and Game Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last paragraph  
(same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Whenever a guide is convicted of having violated any provisions  
of the inland fish and game laws, or any of the rules and  
regulations established by the commissioner for the licensing of  
guides, said commissioner shall may suspend a guide's license  
~~for~~ not to exceed 2 years and shall may deny the right to hunt  
or fish for 2-years the same period.'
