**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Canton Water District for Costs of Relocating
Pipes because of Highway Construction.**

Canton Water District; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$13,000 from the General Highway Fund to the Canton Water District of Canton, to reimburse the expenses of relocating water pipes caused by highway construction on Route 108.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Due to highway construction and alteration of Route 108, it became necessary for the Canton Water District to relocate its water pipes.
