COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 598, L. D. 1769, RESOLVE,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Affecting the
Apportionment of the House of Representatives.

Amend said Resolve by striking out all of that part
designated Section 2 and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Section 2. Number of Representatives. The House of
Representatives shall consist of such number of Representatives,
as will be determined by a ratio of three single member Repre-
sentative Districts to each Senatorial District. Each Repre-
sentative shall be elected for a term of two years from the
day next preceding the meeting of the Legislature.'
