STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Conferring Associate Degrees by Husson College.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1965, c. 121, amended. Chapter 121 of the private and special laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Degrees. In addition to the rights and privileges and powers granted to Husson College by chapter 11 of the private and special laws of 1953, as amended by chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1963, and granted by chapter 90 of the private and special laws of 1969, Husson College, a nonprofit corporation, of Bangor, Maine, is authorized, by appropriate action of its trustees, to confer upon all who successfully complete a 2-year course of instruction in the field of Business Science any of the fields of science instruction, now or from time to time, offered by the college, an Associate Degree in Business Science Degree.
