HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1412, L. D. 1779, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Public
Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 63 the following new section:

'Sec. 63-A. R.S., T. 30, § 2311, sub-§2, amended.

Subsection 2 of section 2311 of Title 30 of the Revised

Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 438 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding at the end the following sentences:

In addition the following town officials may be elected by ballot: Moderator, assessors, overseers of the poor and treasurer. The election of officials at the last annual town meeting shall be deemed such elected town officials until the town otherwise designates.'
