

STATE OF MAINE SENATE 104th LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 604, L. D. 1784, Bill, "AN ACT Creating a Commission to Study Means of Increasing the Effectiveness and Capability of the Maine Legislature."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of the last paragraph (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following paragraph:

'The members of the commission shall serve without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. The commission shall be authorized to choose its own chairman, employ such professional and clerical assistance as it shall deem necessary within the limits of funds provided, accept contributions for purposes consistent with the objectives of this Act. The term of the commission shall expire December 31, 1970.'
