COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 611, L.D. 1787, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Death Benefit for Parents Under Workmen's
Compensation Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'R. S., T. 39, § 58-A, additional. Title 39 of the
Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 58-A, to
read as follows:

§ 58-A. Death benefits to parents

If the employee is under the age of 30 years and dies
as the result of injury within the meaning of this Act and
said employee is not survived by a widow or children who would
be eligible to receive benefits under this Act, and where no
other compensation is payable as a result of said injury,
except medical expenses and funeral expenses provided for in
this Act, a payment of \$10,000 shall be made to the living
parent or parents. This section shall in no way exempt the
insurance carrier from complying with section 57 relating to
the second injury fund. Parentage and method of payments
shall be determined by the commission. If more than one
parent is living, each shall share equally.'
