**AN ACT Relating to Death Benefit for Parents Under Workmen's
Compensation Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 59-A, additional. Title 39 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 58-A, to read as follows:

§ 58-A. Death benefits to parents

If the employee dies as a result of the injury, the employer shall pay, in addition to any compensation, medical benefits and funeral expenses provided for in this Act, a lump sum payment of \$10,000 to the living parent or parents of the deceased employee.
