#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SEVENTY

AN ACT Relating to Hours of Sale Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. The first sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 44-A of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

No licensee, by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall sell or deliver any liquor in this State on any day, including Sunday, between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m.; and no liquor shall be sold or delivered in this State on Sundays between the hours of 6 a.m. and midnight, except as provided.
