**AN ACT Relating to Hours of Sale Under Liquor Laws.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended.** The first sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 44-A of chapter 504 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**No licensee, by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall sell or deliver any liquor in this State on any day, including Sunday, between 1 a.m. and 6 a.m.; and no liquor shall be sold or delivered in this State on Sundays between the hours of 6 a.m. and midnight, except as provided.**
