SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1430, L.D. 1800, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Licensing of Ambulance Service, Vehicles and Personnel."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the word "service" in the 6th line of section 1 (5th line in L.D.) the underlined words 'for hire'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following section:

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 32, §62, sub-§4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 62 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 359 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

4. Ambulance service. "Ambulance service" means any organization or any person or persons setting themselves forth as providing for hire transportation for ill or injured persons.'
