SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 632, L.D. 1804, Bill,
"AN ACT Clarifying Laws Relating to the University of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 (same in L.D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1961, c. 247, §5, repealed and replaced. Section 5 of chapter 247 of the private and special laws of 1961 is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Sec. 5. Political purposes. The Maine ETV network shall neither accept advertising nor engage in editorializing, nor support or oppose any candidate for political office, and shall in all respects operate under the rules and regulations of the Communications Act of 1934, and the Federal Communications Commission.'
