HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1439, L. D. 1814, Bill,
"AN ACT Establishing a Human Rights Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of paragraph B of subsection 1 of that part designated "§4573" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'B. Retirement plan. Observe the terms of a bona fide seniority system or any bona fide employee benefit plan such as a retirement, pension or insurance plan.'

Further amend said Bill in paragraph A of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4613" by striking out in the first line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "the victim" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'any person who has been the subject'
