SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1439, L.D. 1814, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing a Human Rights Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 13 of that part designated "§4566" of section 1.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering subsection 14 of that part designated "§4566" of section 1 to be subsection 13.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subparagraph (5) of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4613" of section 1.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering subparagraph (6) of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4613" to be subparagraph (5).

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of subparagraph (7) of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4613" of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

' (6) An order to pay in cases of unlawful price discrimination the victim thereof 3 times the amount of any excessive price demanded and paid by reason of such unlawful discrimination;'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering subparagraph (8) of paragraph B of subsection 2 of that part designated "§4613" of section 1 to be subparagraph (7).
