

STATE-OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATAVES 104th LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1441, L. D. 1816, Bill, "AN ACT Repealing the Property Tax Certificate Requirement for Registration of Watercraft."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 2 the following new section:

'Sec. 2-A. R. S., T. 38, §234, sub-§1, amended. The first sentence of subsection 1 of section 234 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The owner shall make application to the bureau on forms approved by the 2 bureau heads. Such application shall show the legal residence of the applicant and the place where the boat is situated.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following new section:

'Sec. 5. R. S., T. 38, §234, sub-§10, additional. Section 234 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 10 to read as follows:

10. Notice to assessors. Within 30 days of receipt of an application for a certificate of number, the bureau shall comply with the following: Where the legal residence of the applicant is a municipality within the State, the bureau shall mail a copy of the application to the assessors or assessor of such municipality. Where the legal residence is outside of the State and the boat is situated within a municipality in the State, the bureau shall Mailing Mo. H-157) <u>mail a copy of the application to the assessors or assessor of</u> <u>such municipality. In all other cases, the bureau shall trans-</u> <u>fer a copy of the application to the Bureau of Taxation.</u>'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 10th line from the end (9th line in L. D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure "Sec. 3." and inserting in place thereof the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 4.'
