HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to H. P. 1449, L. D. 1825, Bill, "AN ACT
Abolishing Full-Time County Attorneys and Increasing Salaries of

and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, and notwithstanding the provisions of the Revised Statutes,
Title 30, section 3, this Act shall take effect on March 1, 1970.'
