HOUSE AMENDMENT " D " to H. P. 1449, L. D. 1825, Bill,
"AN ACT Abolishing Full-Time County Attorneys and Increasing
Salaries of Certain County Attorneys and Assistant County
Attorneys."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line of section 10 (same
in L. D.) by striking out the underlined figure "\$9,000"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$8,000'

Further amend said Bill by adding after section 10
(same in L.D.) a new section, as follows:

'Sec. 10-A. Effective date. Notwithstanding any other
provision of this Act, section 10 of this Act shall become
effective January 1, 1971.'
